Teams will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. Ten (10) teams per division. You may not compete on more than one (1) team. Adult co-ed teams will be in the Men's Division. Waiver must be completely filled out and signed.

- \$30 stock charge; \$20 of entry will be jack-potted back; 50% 1ST, 30% 2ND & 20% 3RD.
- Team Captain will receive team payout. It is up to the captain to distribute funds.

Sponsor, Team Parent and/or Team Captain is responsible for informing all team members of the following: Players must wear shirt, pants and shoes for safety reasons. NO GLOVES, spikes, hooks or any other object to help catch the pig is allowed. START: 2 players must be on each side of entry gate with one hand on the fence. NO pulling pig ears, tail, legs or hitting the pig or otherwise harm the animal. This is cause for Disqualification. The team must work together to get the pig in the barrel butt first. Barrel must be upright at all times. Players must clean up to reenter grandstands. The Judge's Ruling is Final.
